

Simple Reminders

The Club does not offer “split cards”. When you purchase a Bird Card, you and your spouse are considered members of the Club. Anyone else you bring would be a guest. During weekdays, you are welcome to bring as many guests as you wish to be responsible for. Please remember, you are always responsible for the conduct of your guests! During weekends, all members are restricted to hunting parties no larger than four (4) persons. We have found in the past that offering a “split card” created friction when the parties involved could not amicably agree upon what birds each would shoot. We have also found that it becomes increasingly difficult to enforce the Club’s Safety Rules and Regulations when more than one accountable person is assigned to a membership. For these reasons, we do not allow or offer a “split card”.

Each person at the Club, whether a Member or a guest, must sign in and out of the Sign-In Book every time they visit the Club. This sign in process is mandated by the CA Department of Fish and Wildlife, and all persons using the Club are required to follow the Rules and Regulations. You must include your license plate number(2) for any vehicles present. Please note, it is NOT acceptable to “sign out early”. Everybody must sign out the actual time they leave. Members are welcome to have a guest meet them here at the Club at any time, but they MUST meet their guests at the Clubhouse. A guest may not travel into the fields without their member being present. No one can sign another person into the Club. Each person must sign themselves in and out.

All members are welcome to either request a refund of their Card payments, or to request a one time roll-over of funds paid to the following Season, as long as this request is received by the 30th of September. After the 1st of October no refund requests are taken or honored. Pheasants are considered perishable items. The Club buys their birds from breeders at a set quantity, with a reasonable expectation that the birds will be hunted during the pheasant season. The birds arrive on a regularly scheduled basis, and have been paid for when delivered. They are released with an expectation that the registered number of members with current Bird Cards will be here to hunt. If the Club were to offer refunds for an extended period of time into the Season each, the costs of birds would rapidly increase, and a large number of birds would be simply destroyed without ever being hunted, thus becoming wasted.
